First entry of each dog (includes a \$3.50 AKC fee) \$27.00

Catalog: The Agility catalog information will be included in the main event catalog.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

A refund of the entry fee will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g., walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 26" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.

Preferred Class Information

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW and FAST, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Preferred Class Information

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

Move-ups, Errors, Confirmation Protocols

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by **6 pm, Pacific time, Monday, September 12, 2011**. Requests for move-ups over the phone **will not be accepted**. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day.

AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION

Awards

A Top Dog Awards of an embroidered chair will be given each day to the highest scoring dog. Criteria for calculating the scoring for the Top Dog Award can be found in the General Information booklet. On Thursday, First Place in each class will receive an embroidered hand towel. Second thru Fourth place in each class will receive a dog toy valued between \$1.00 to \$3.00. On Friday, First Place in each class will receive a duffle bag. Second thru Fourth place in each class will receive a dog toy valued between \$1.00 to \$3.00. Rosette ribbons will be awarded for each placement and qualifying run.

OBSTACLES AND EQUIPMENT

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it. Weave poles with 24" spacing will be used at these trials.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These events are open to all Border Collies which have been registered with The American Kennel Club or have been granted an PAL/ILP number which are fifteen (15) months of age or older, except for bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This trial is NOT accepting entries for dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes:

8" for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 4"
12" for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 8"
16" for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 12"
20" for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 16"
24" for dogs over 22 inches at the withers	Preferred class: 20"
26" dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion	Preferred class: N/A

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the Dogs To Be Measured List. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.** For complete details on the Jump Height Card Process go to www.k-9sports.com and click on the link on the Events page.

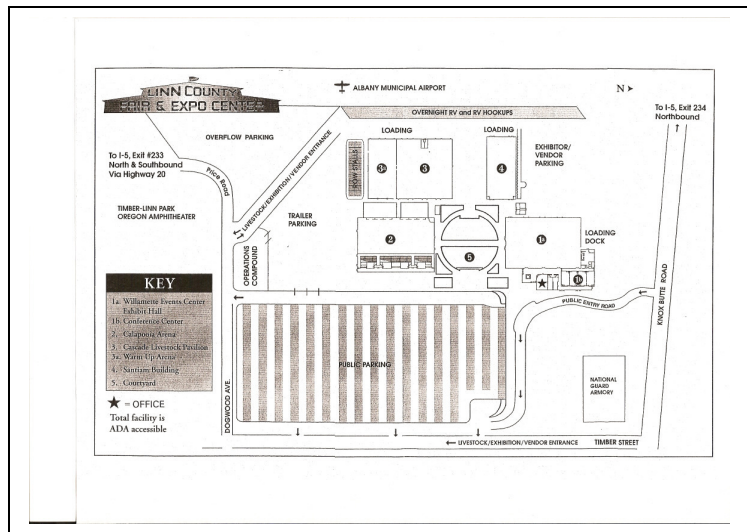
Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all judging and recording fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs, or bitches in season. No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial. Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The Border Collie Society of America, Linn County Fairgrounds and K-9 Sports LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The Border Collie Society of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- The Border Collie Society of America has chosen NOT to arbitrate claims as indicated on the back of the entry form.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

There will be crating on the elevated spectator area around the competition. Crating space is somewhat limited, so we ask that you please conserve on space so that everyone who needs crating will be able to find a spot.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
