## **Running Order and Class Information**

Please check all your trial information carefully on the confirmation you were sent and notify me immediately in writing with any corrections. You can contact me via email at [LKSAGE@bctonline.com](mailto:LKSAGE@bctonline.com) or by phone (503) 632-2227.

**SITE INFO:** This trial will be held in two rings indoors on packed dirt. There will be crating on the elevated spectator area around the competition. Crating space is somewhat limited, so we ask that you please conserve on space so that everyone who needs crating will be able to find a spot. Please bring chairs, crates, water and clean up tools for your dogs. **The Welsh Springer Spaniel National Specialty Agility Trial will be going on on Thursday beginning at 2pm. You may set up your crating space Thursday afternoon but please be respectful of the dogs running that day.**

Please DO NOT crate along the railings or ring side. There is also covered crating outside along the building. Also a reminder that this agility trial is being held in conjunction with the Chintimini Kennel Club breed show. Note, there is a \$5 parking fee for day parking on Saturday and Sunday. Chintimini Kennel Club has added another unloading area. If you are parking in the Day Parking, please unload at the main entrance to the Calapooia Arena which is on the east side of the building. They also ask that the RV and overnight folks unload through the RV entrance.

### **DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:**

*From the North, on I-5:* Take EXIT 234A toward Fair/Expo/Knox Butte. Turn slight right onto Airport Road SE. Turn right onto Pacific Blvd. SE/OR-99E. Stay straight to go onto Knox Butte Road E. End at 3700 Knox Butte Road E on the right.

*From the South, on I-5:* Take EXIT 234 toward Fair/Expo/Knox Butte. Turn right onto Knox Butte Road E. End at 3700 Knox Butte Road E on the right.

**ARMBANDS:** If you marked that your dog has a permanent height card, armbands will be available to pick up at the trial secretary table each morning in binders, alphabetical by Handler's Last Name. If you don't see your armband(s), then your dog needs to be measured or show a height card. There is no formal check-in. There will be new armbands each day. Please check in with the gate steward prior to running in your class.

**MEASURING:** All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24" and 26" dogs. Paula Ratoza is a VMO and can measure your dog for their permanent height card. This also means that ALL dogs without height cards, including 24" and 26" will need to be measured. Handlers whose dogs need to be measured will not be able to get their armbands until they are measured. We will have a judge available to measure dogs from 7 am to 8 am each day near the trial secretary's table.

**GENERAL:** ALL dogs are required to be kept on leash at ALL times. And please pick up after your dogs.

**VOLUNTEERS:** Brenda Veldink and Debbie Cooper will be the Chief Ring Stewards ([snostrm@comcast.net](mailto:snostrm@comcast.net) and [debra\\_cooper@beavton.k12.or.us](mailto:debra_cooper@beavton.k12.or.us)). They will be coordinating the final schedule at the trial and will also use the white board for sign-ups. If you can, please volunteer for the class(es) that you can help with. CRAC will issue raffle tickets to each worker to be used in a workers raffle which will have many wonderful things and services. The workers raffle will be drawn around noon on Sunday. Prizes must be claimed by the conclusion of the trial on Sunday.

**CONFLICTS:** We will do our best to accommodate conflicts. If you have a conflict, Standard takes precedence over FAST and JWW. Put a "C" instead of a check mark on both gate sheets so the scribe and gate stewards will know you have a conflict.

**MOVE-UPS:** The deadline for move-ups is Monday, March 29, 2010 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial.

**FOOD: Burton's Catering** will be the food vendor on site and will be open from 7:30 am to the end of the trial each day. In addition, there are fast food restaurants within a couple of miles of the fairgrounds.
