Running Order and Class Information

Please check all your trial information carefully on the confirmation you were sent and notify me immediately in writing with any corrections. You can contact me via email at LKSAGE@bctonline.com or by phone (503) 632-2227(home) or (503) 840-4303 (cell).

Due to an illness, Edie Allyn will not be able to judge for us this weekend. Craig Josling will be replacing her and we are looking forward to having him. If you wish to withdraw your entry because of this judge change, you may do so and receive a full refund.

SITE INFO: This trial will be held in two rings indoors on packed dirt. Crating is on concrete around the periphery of the rings. **You may set up your crating space Friday afternoon beginning at 4 pm.**

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From I-5: Take EXIT 9 (in Washington), head West on 179th Ave. for ½ mile, turn left onto 2nd Ave., then turn left again at Gate 7. Exposition and Equestrian Bldg. is on the right, at the end of the road. Feel free to park in any marked parking spot around the arena building. Please do not block any arena entrance or access road.

CLASS SCHEDULE:

Saturday: TALL to SMALL – First dog on the line at 8:00am

Ring 1 (Craig Josling): Excellent FAST, Excellent Standard, Open Standard, Novice Standard

Ring 2 (Victoria MacVicar): Open FAST, Novice FAST, Novice JWW, Open JWW, Excellent JWW

Sunday: SMALL to TALL – First dog on the line at 8:00am

Ring 1 (Victoria MacVicar): Excellent FAST, Excellent Standard, Open Standard, Novice Standard

Ring 2 (Craig Josling): Open FAST, Novice FAST, Novice JWW, Open JWW, Excellent JWW

ARMBANDS: If you marked that your dog has a permanent height card, armbands will be available for pick up at the trial secretary table each morning in binders, alphabetical by Handler's Last Name. If you don't see your armband(s), then your dog needs to be measured or show a height card. There is no formal check-in. There will be new armbands each day. Please check in with the gate steward prior to running in your class.

MEASURING: All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24" and 26" dogs. We will not have a VMO available at this trial. Handlers whose dogs need to be measured will not be able to get their armbands until they are measured. We will have a judge available to measure dogs from 7 am to 8 am each day near the trial secretary's table.

GENERAL: ALL dogs are required to be kept on leash at ALL times. And please pick up after your dogs.

VOLUNTEERS: The trial chairperson is Debbie Cooper, (503) 313-3386 or email debra_cooper@beavton.k12.or.us Karin Pearson-King and Ronwin Ashton will be the Chief Ring Stewards. They will be coordinating the final schedule at the trial and will also use the white board for sign-ups. If you can, please volunteer for the class(es) that you can help with. CRAC will

issue raffle tickets to each worker to be used in a DAILYworkers raffle which will have many wonderful items and services. The workers raffle will be drawn each day in the early afternoon. Extra special items in the raffle will be drawn on Sunday after 1pm. There will be a special raffle draw which will occur daily for those volunteering as chute setters or leash runners. Prizes must be claimed by the conclusion of the trial on Sunday.

CONFLICTS: We will do our best to accommodate conflicts. If you have a conflict, Standard takes precedence over FAST and JWW. Put a "C" instead of a check mark on both gate sheets so the scribe and gate stewards will know you have a conflict.

MOVE-UPS: The deadline for move-ups is Monday, June 6, 2011 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial.

FOOD: Chewey's will be the food vendor on site and will be open from 7:30 am to the end of the trial each day.
