AKC Agility Trial ~ June 24-26, 2011

Due to circumstances beyond our control, The Columbia River Agility Club June 24-26,2011 Trial scheduled to be held in Albany, OR has been moved to the Oregon State Fairgrounds in Salem, Oregon. This new site is just 35 minutes North of Albany and only a few miles off of I-5. The arena is covered with partially open walls. The surface is compacted dirt and very similar to that of the Albany arena.

There are plenty of RV hookups, some with electrical only, and some with electric, water and sewer. If you are planning on bringing an RV and need to reserve a space, please go to my website www.k-9sports.com and download the Revised Premium with the new RV Reservation Form and send it to me with your payment. Please note that this is a different procedure than what was published in the premium for the Albany facility, where you made your reservations directly with the facility. For the Oregon State Fairgrounds RV reservations you **must** send them directly to me.

One big change to note is the crating. We will now be crating outside the ring so plan on bringing your canopies for cover. Hopefully we will have nice summer weather for this weekend. It's been pretty good in the past so I'm keeping my fingers crossed. I will be posting new directions to the facility on my site as well.

We will be the only event being held in the horse area of the fairgrounds. There is a large event booked for the rest of the fairgrounds but shouldn't be a concern to us as we will be using a different entrance and there is fencing between our arena and the other areas. I think we will be just fine moving to Salem and they are happy to have us.

There will be a food vendor on site. I'll provide more info on that in your final confirmation.
