Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:

CRAC is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67% . If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

UNLIMITED ENTRY – send in your entry on your schedule – but be sure we receive it prior to the closing date of Saturday, May 23, 2009 at 7:00 pm.

A refund of the entry fee, less the AKC recording fees and judging fee per day will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height

divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 26" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

Move-ups and Errors

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by **4 pm, Pacific time, Monday, June 1, 2009**. Requests for move-ups over the phone **will not be accepted**. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day.

Awards

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

First Place: Blue Ribbon ~ Second Place: Red Ribbon ~ Third Place: Yellow Ribbon
Fourth Place: White Ribbon ~ Qualifying Score: Dark Green Rosette

MACH & PAX ribbons and bars will be presented to dogs completing those titles

If you & your dog are close to a MACH or PAX, please let a member of the trial committee know.

CRAC will be awarding High in Trial Special Rosette Ribbons, for runs on Saturday only, to the highest combined score from two clean rounds, for all dogs entered in the show, in the regular classes for each of the AKC Recognized Breed Groups (Sporting, Hound, Working, Terrier, Toy, Non-Sporting and Herding). Scores of 100 in both classes is required to be in contention. Scoring is based on the highest combined YPS.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it. Weave poles with 24" spacing will be used at these trials.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all **regular classes:**

8"	for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 4"
12"	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 8"
16"	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 12"
20"	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 16"
24"	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers	Preferred class: 20"
26"	dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion	Preferred class: N/A

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all **international classes (if offered):**

14"	for dogs 13-3/4 inches and under at the withers (mini dogs)
18"	for dogs 16-7/8 inches and under at the withers (midi dogs)
26"	for dogs over 16-7/8 inches at the withers (maxi dogs)

Jump Height Information

Please include a copy of your dogs' jump height card with your entry. All entries must include a copy of your dog's height card. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or and AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured.

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW and FAST, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Preferred Class Information

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs, or bitches in season. No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial. Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The Columbia River Agility Club, Clark County Fairgrounds and K-9 Sports LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The Columbia River Agility Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Ring & Crating Information

There is plenty of crating at this site. All crating is on concrete, around the periphery of the rings. Please do not block exits/entrances, and do not crate on any elevated platform you may find around the ring(s). You may arrive for crating set-up after 4:00 pm on Friday.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
