Running Order and Class Information

Please check all your trial information carefully on the confirmation you were sent and notify me immediately in writing with any corrections. You can contact me via email at LKSAGE@bctonline.com or by phone (503) 840-4303.

SITE INFO: This trial will be held in two rings indoors on packed dirt. There will be crating on the elevated spectator area around the competition. **Please note there will be space in the crating area sectioned off for the English Springer Spaniels only. Please respect their space.** Crating space is somewhat limited, so we ask that you please conserve on space so that everyone who needs crating will be able to find a spot. Please bring chairs, crates, water and clean up tools for your dogs. **The arena will be open for set up beginning at 4pm on Friday. We will be setting up the scoring table along the rail just north of the stairs leading down to the ring so please do NOT set up your crates in this space. We reserve the right to move your set-up should it conflict with our scoring area.**

Please DO NOT crate along the railings or ring side. There is also covered crating outside along the building. Day parking is free and is located in the parking lot on the East side of the building.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From the North, on I-5: Take EXIT 234A toward Fair/Expo/Knox Butte. Turn slight right onto Airport Road SE. Turn right onto Pacific Blvd. SE/OR-99E. Stay straight to go onto Knox Butte Road E. End at 3700 Knox Butte Road E on the right.

From the South, on I-5: Take EXIT 234 toward Fair/Expo/Knox Butte. Turn right onto Knox Butte Road E. End at 3700 Knox Butte Road E on the right.

Ring 2(Paula Ratoza): Novice JWW, Open JWW, Excellent JWW

ARMBANDS: If you marked that your dog has a permanent height card, armbands will be available for pick up at the trial secretary table each morning in binders, alphabetical by Handler's Last Name. If you don't see your armband(s), then your dog needs to be measured or show a height card. There is no formal check-in. There will be new armbands each day. Please check in with the gate steward prior to running in your class.

MEASURING: Paula Ratoza is a VMO so ALL dogs without height cards will have to be measured, including 24" and 26" dogs. Handlers whose dogs need to be measured will not be able to get their armbands until they are measured. We will have a judge available to measure dogs from 7 am to 8 am each day near the trial secretary's table.

GENERAL: ALL dogs are required to be kept on leash at ALL times. And please pick up after your dogs.

VOLUNTEERS: Traci Bruchok will be the Chief Ring Steward and will be coordinating the final schedule for volunteers at the trial and will also use the white board for sign-ups. If you can, please volunteer for the class(es) that you can help with. ESSFTA will give \$5 coupons to each worker to be used towards food from the food vendor. There will also be a raffle for a jump.

CONFLICTS: We will do our best to accommodate conflicts. If you have a conflict, Standard takes precedence over JWW. Put a "C" instead of a check mark on both gate sheets so the scribe and gate stewards will know you have a conflict.

MOVE-UPS: The deadline for move-ups is Monday, Sept 27, 2010 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial.

FOOD: Burton's Catering will be the food vendor on site and will be open from 7:30 am to the end of the trial each day. In addition, there are fast food restaurants within a couple of miles of the fairgrounds.
