ENTRIES AND CHANGES – Incomplete or inaccurate forms will NOT be accepted. Please, no hand deliveries. NOTE: The address is a PO Box which does not accept UPS, Federal Express, Airborne, etc. If you use express mail, check the box “Signature Waived”. Requests for changes or move-ups to your entry must be received in writing or emailed to the Trial Secretary by July 11, 2011.

MEASURING - Only dogs entering the Small and Medium dog classes (i.e., classes in which the dog’s wither height is 18” and under) that do not have permanent AKC or NADAC height cards are required to be measured at the time of check-in. Copies of height cards may be presented at the trial or mailed with entry.

TRIAL SITE INFORMATION

The trial will be two rings, 100’ x 100’, outdoors on grass/dirt. Equipment may include: Dog walk, A-Frame, Teeter, Closed tunnel, Open tunnel, Weave Poles, Tire jump, Non-winged jumps, Winged Jumps, Double jump. NOTE: All contact equipment will be slat-less and rubberized.

AWARDS – First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying ribbons or pins will be awarded for each qualifying run.

If you may finish an ATCH during this trial, please inform the Trial Secretary before the trial.

CAMPING

- Kitsap Memorial State Park: Located 5 miles south of Port Gamble has RV and camping spaces available. www.parks.wa.gov

DIRECTIONS TO PORT GAMBLE: State Hwy 104 & Teekalet Ave:

From Seattle/Bainbridge Island/Poulsbo (about ½ hour from Ferry): Take the Washington State Ferry from Seattle to Bainbridge Island. Exit ferry, go straight on WA-305, through Poulsbo. Turn right onto WA-3 North. Continue north for 6.3 miles to traffic light/intersection for Hood Canal Bridge. Continue straight (do not turn onto bridge) on WA-104 for 1.4 miles to Port Gamble. Trial site will be on left side of road.

From Edmonds/Kingston (about 15 minutes from Ferry): Take the Washington State Ferry from Edmonds to Kingston. Follow ferry traffic straight onto WA-104. Go 3.7 miles. Turn right at the light to continue on WA-104 and drive for 3.7 miles to Port Gamble. Follow WA-104 around 90 degree turn to left. Trial site will be ~0.2 miles on right side of road.

From Olympia/Tacoma/Bremerton/Silverdale (about 1 hour from Tacoma Narrows Bridge): Exit Hwy 16 off I-5, and drive 29 miles north across Tacoma Narrows Bridge to Gorst. Drive around Sinclair Inlet toward Bremerton onto Hwy 3 North (Hwy 16 becomes Hwy 3 North). Continue on Hwy 3 North for about 25 miles, past Silverdale and Poulsbo exits. Continue north past traffic light and intersection for Hood Canal bridge (do not turn onto bridge), where WA-3 turns into WA-104. Go 1.4 miles to Port Gamble. Trial grounds will be on left side of road.

From Olympic Peninsula (about 45 minutes from Sequim): Take US-101 to WA-104. Exit east on WA-104. Continue on WA-104 East for about 13 miles. After crossing the Hood Canal Bridge, turn left at the light onto WA-104. Go 1.4 miles to Port Gamble. Trial site will be on left side of road.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) and the Australian Shepherd Club of Washington with Muddy Paws Agility Club of Kitsap (MudPACK) as the sponsor club. Exhibitors through submission of their entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, including the following rules regarding entry.

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA agility trials.
- Handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- When dog(s) are left unattended, they must be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers who tether or improperly secure their dogs, will be excused from the show grounds.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization(s). Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for the dismissal.
- A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to the closing date. Requests for a refund of entry fees after the closing date, up to the day before the trial, will be honored less any expenses incurred by MudPACK, and will be issued for the following reasons: bitches in heat, dogs injured or ill (with verification from vet on request) or family emergency. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for bank-returned checks.

- The Junior Handler Division is open to any dog that is being handled by a junior handler who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes have the option to jump at their regular jump height or 4" lower height.
- The Veterans Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older, or any handler aged 60 or older, or any handler who has a certificate of disability. Dogs entered in the Veterans Division classes will jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current ASCA Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook.
- A copy of the current ASCA Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook may be downloaded free from the ASCA web site: www.asca.org

ASCA ENTRY INFORMATION

- All ASCA agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- Dogs do not have to have an ASCA registration or tracking number to participate in an ASCA agility trial.
- If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's ASCA registration number where designated on the entry form.
- If your dog is not an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA tracking number for your dog. Any dog is eligible to get an ASCA tracking number (not just Australian Shepherds). Once you have an ASCA tracking number, use it as your dog's "ASCA Registration Number" on all entry forms. ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number Forms are included in this premium. They can also be obtained at ASCA's website (www.asca.org) under "Forms".

AGREEMENT

1.1 As used here "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owners, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor/owner assumes the risk of any harm arising from these hazards..

1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA, the Australian Shepherd Club of Washington and Muddy Paws Agility Club of Kitsap (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), Port Gamble/Olympic Resource Management (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor /owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.**
