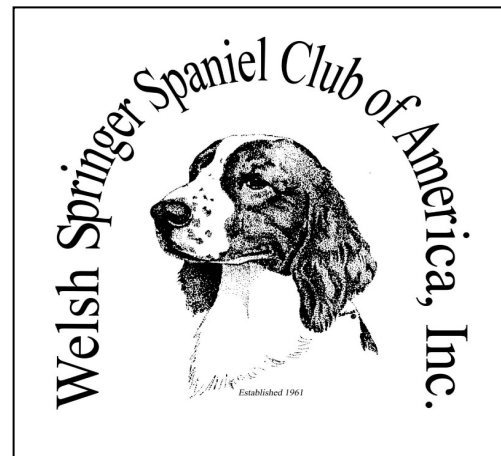

Take Knox Butte Road East for 1.6 miles

Turn Right onto Scrael Hill Rd. SE. Go for 1.2 miles.

Turn Left onto US-20, Santiam Hwy. Go 4.0 miles.

Turn Left onto Hwy 220. Go 2.5 miles.

Turn Left onto Cold Springs Road. Go 0.3 miles.

Turn Left onto Crabtree Drive. Go 0.8 miles.

Turn Right onto Gilkey Road. Go 2.9 miles.

Stay Right on Gilkey Road. Go 0.4 miles.

Slight Right onto Rodgers Drive. Go 0.4 miles.

Turn Right onto S. Ruby Loop. Go 1.2 miles.

38750 is on the Left at the end of S. Ruby Loop

**Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to insure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**Extreme weather conditions:** The AKC believes that the welfare of dogs and participants is of paramount importance. In the case of adverse weather conditions, the test could be canceled or rescheduled.
