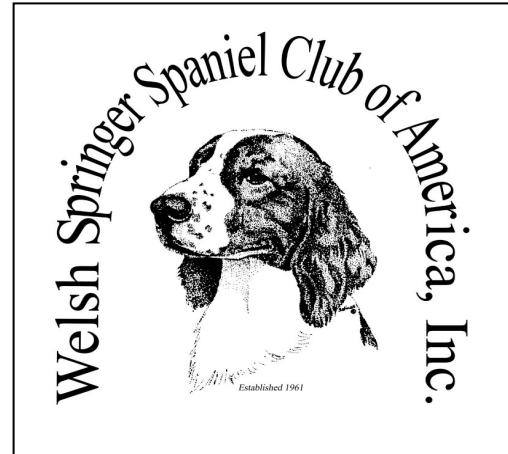

Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Wednesday, March 17, 2010, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Lori Sage, PO Box 3381, Tualatin, OR 97062. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 payable in US dollars. A \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to PNWWSSC.

Certification: Each entry for a dog that has not previously passed an AKC Tracking Dog Test must be accompanied by a written statement, dated within one year of the date of the test, signed by a person approved by AKC to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. Certifications will be returned to entrants who do not run their dogs in this test.

Tracking Test Entries: Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog shall not be barred from competition; however, Welsh Springer Spaniels not having a TD will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 6 Welsh Springer Spaniels.

The Draw: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Wednesday, March 17, 2010 at 7:00 PM at the home of the Test Secretary, 25170 S. Dianne Dr., Beavercreek, OR 97004. Contact the Secretary for directions if you wish to attend this drawing.

Alternate List: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

Notification: Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Refund Policy: The entry fee shall be refunded if either 1) the entrant notifies the secretary prior to the drawing for tracks and an alternate runs the track or 2) the dog is an alternate who does not run the track.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

Draw for running order: All entrants must be at the test site by 8:00 AM on Thursday, April 1, 2010, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

Judging will begin as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged. The tracking test hours are 6 AM to 8 PM.

Awards: A dark green rosette will be awarded to each passing dog. WSSCA and PNWWSSC will also offer Commemorative Plaque, Green Bandana and a WSSCA "Q" pin. Each Welsh Springer Spaniel participant earns a dog toy.

Dogs on leash: All dogs and bitches entered in this test must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dogs and handler being excused from the test site and any awards earned will be withheld. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone to the test.

Directions to test site: From hwy 99, turn West on hwy 36. Go approx. 5 miles to Cheshire. After passing Dari-Mart continue approx. 0.5 mile and turn right (North) onto Territorial Road. Go approx. 1 mile and look for Tracking Test signs on the left at driveway entrance. If you get to High Pass Road, you went too far.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to insure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Extreme weather conditions: The AKC believes that the welfare of dogs and participants is of paramount importance. In the case of adverse weather conditions, the test could be canceled or rescheduled.

AKC Rules: All entrants are responsible for complying with the AKC Rules regarding Tracking Tests and other AKC Rules referred to in the Tracking Test rule book.

Post Test Brunch: All participants are invited to partake at a celebration brunch held at the test site following the completion of the tracking test.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
